

Microsoft Whiteboard for Students

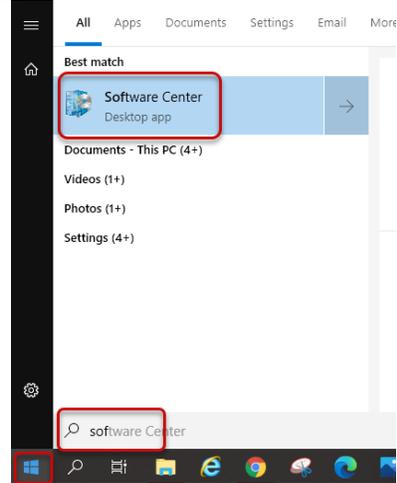
Microsoft Whiteboard is a freeform, digital canvas where ideas and content come together in a digital world. The canvas is designed for pen, touch, keyboard and seamlessly integrates with Teams and mobile devices.

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Installing the app

1. Click the **Windows** icon in the lower left corner of the screen.
2. **Search** Software Center.
3. Click to open the **Software Center**.



4. Click to open the **Microsoft Whiteboard** application.

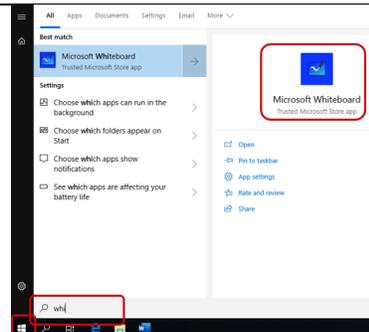


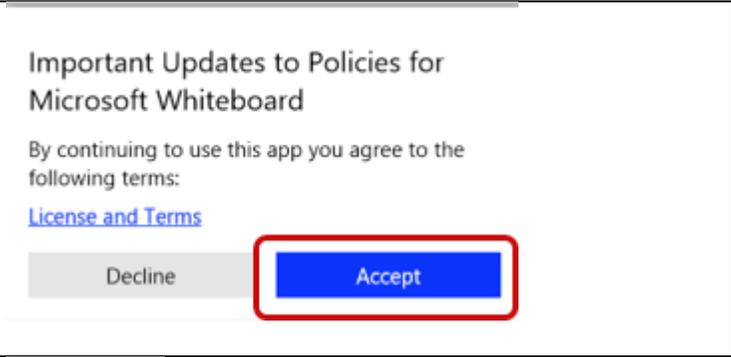
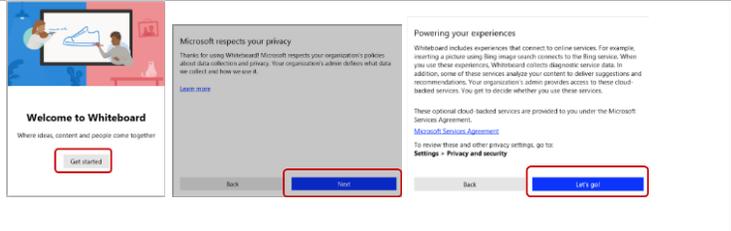
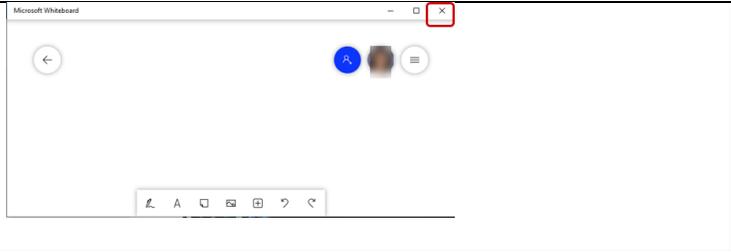
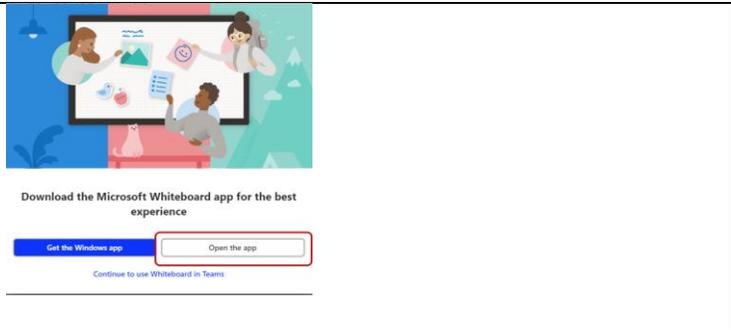
5. Click **Install**.

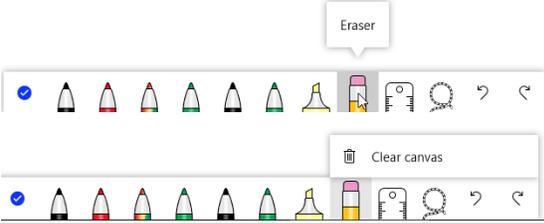
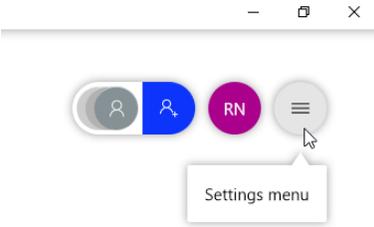


Opening Microsoft Whiteboard

3. Click to open **Microsoft Whiteboard**.

<p>1. Once the teacher shares the Whiteboard app, in a Teams Meeting, click Open in app.</p>	 <p>Open in app</p>

<p>Pens</p> <p>Double click on any pen to customize the width and color.</p>	
<p>Highlighter</p> <p>Double click on the highlighter to customize the width and color.</p>	
<p>Eraser and Clear Canvas</p> <p>Click once for the eraser and twice to display the Clear Canvas menu.</p>	
<p>Ruler</p> <p>Use two fingers on the touch screen to rotate the ruler or hold the Shift key and roll the scroll bar on the mouse.</p>	
<p>Lasso Tool</p> <p>The Lasso tool allows you to select one or more elements on the board. Just drag the tool around the elements you want to select. You can either move them together or delete them all at once.</p>	
<p>Undo and Redo</p> <p>Select the undo and redo buttons to remove and return text and objects.</p>	
<p>Settings</p>	
<p>Click the settings menu to expand and display the settings options.</p>	

1. Active pen – This will allow you to move the canvas with the mouse and draw with the pen simultaneously.	
2. Ink to shape – Hand-drawn shapes turn into precise shapes.	
3. Ink to table – Hand-drawn table turn into a clean and organized table.	
4. Object snapping - Object snapping helps you align your content by providing a visual cue.	
5. Export – Save the board as a .jpeg or .svg.	
6. Send to OneNote – Copy the Whiteboard canvas to a OneNote Notebook.	
7. Post to Teams – Send the board to a MS Team.	
8. Format Background – Customize the background color and style.	
9. Toolbar location -Choose from right, left and bottom locations for the toolbar.	
10. Clear canvas – Delete everything.	
11. Accessibility Checker - Make sure the board is legible for everyone.	

Zooming In and Out

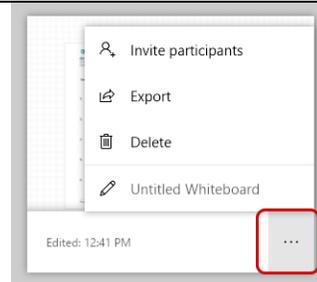
Double click to zoom in and out of board.	
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View all Whiteboards

1. Click the back arrow in the upper-left corner of the application.	
2. All Whiteboards displayed.	

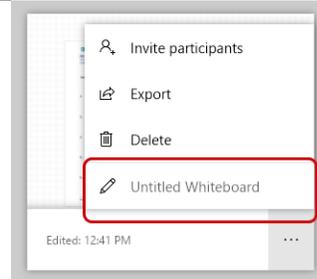
Accessing the Whiteboard Menu

1. Click the **ellipsis** to display the Whiteboard menu.

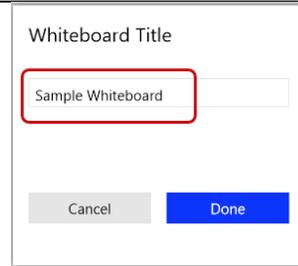


Naming the Whiteboard
